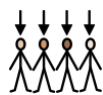
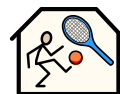




School Council Minutes

1. Thank you to everyone who participated in the survey about certificates of



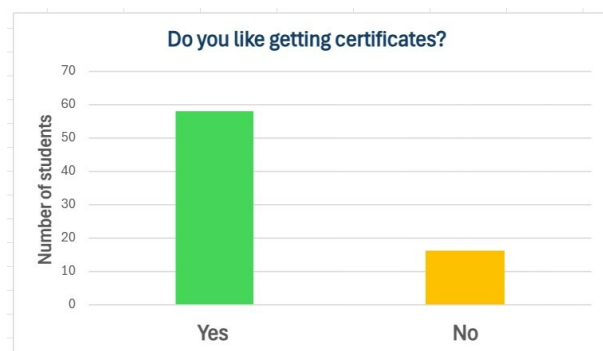
achievement. 58 said 'yes' I like certificates' and 16 said 'no'. There

2. Shared  second  letter  from  Tim  Farron and  Traffic  Director  Victoria about








 road safety.  Hopefully  20mph  zone  to be  extended to Appleby  Road.  Ella  to  find







 WhatThreeWords and  take photo of  our  crossing to the  community  garden. We






will then  reply to  Tim and  Victoria.

4.  Councillors  took a  list of  lunchtime  clubs  back to their  classes. They will




 encourage people  to  find out more about the  new  clubs and give them a  try.







5.  Karen  talked to us  about  World  Down Syndrome  Day on  Friday 21st








 March. We would  like to  wear  fun  socks but there were  other  ideas  too.







 You  could also wear a  funny  hat and  decorate a  t-shirt with  pens.  Chloe
