The programme was officially launched in 2019 and works alongside the Gatsby Benchmarks. There is an expanded framework specifically for Special Schools.

Each area works through a series of steps building skills and developing universal language to understand the terms and their meaning /relevance to them as individuals and the world they live in and share with others.

These eight essential skills areas have been identified as key for future learning and employment and are recognised in Schools Colleges and the work place. Each of the eight areas has its own passport which can be used to plot students' journey.
